<b>ORIGIN</b>	The Maremma and Radda in Chianti
<b>GRAPES VARIETES</b>	Sangiovese (85%), Cabernet sauvignon (15%)
<b>ALTITUDE</b>	140/160 m S.L.M. / 378 m A.S.L.
<b>VINTAGE</b>	2019
<b>WINEMAKING</b>	The Sangiovese grapes from the Maremma are fermented together with the skins of the Cabernet sauvignon grapes from the estates oldest vineyards in Radda in Chianti.
<b>AGING</b>	Aged nine months on his own fine lees, in stainless steel tanks.
<b>BOTTLE FORMAT</b>	0,750 Lt
<b>PACKAGING FORMAT</b>	Cardboard per 6 and 3 bottles
<b>VITICULTURE / HARVEST</b>	2019 was announced as a classic vintage year. The rain in springtime ensured significant supplies of water, adequate to face a moderately hot summer with little rainfall. The first half of the year was cooler and drier than average, creating a slight delay in the vines' growing cycle (compared to previous years). In general 2019 shows many similarities with the great 1980s vintages. The summer temperatures were at a steady high level, without peaks or heavy rain. Approaching harvest, the grapes were blessed with good weather all through September, with considerable night-day temperature variation. The result were grapes with nearly perfect phenolic ripeness.
